We at Mouldex follow strict Quality Control procedures in all aspects of the manufacture process.

Good Housekeeping	(Cleanness)
Storage	(Materials)
Storage	(Finished Goods)
Production	(Manufacture)
Packaging	(Shipping)
Assembly	(Powder filling)

The Quality Control procedure starts with the ordering of the correct material for a specific component. The material weight, code and cost get logged as standard procedure.

Material is then placed in the material handling area which is a closed and ventilated area.

Specific materials are placed in their respected zones, i.e. Acetal, HIPS and Polypropelene.

Material is booked out from the handling area to the production area, ready for manufacturing.

The material is then placed into the moulding machines which have sealed hopper feeders.

Once the product has been manufactured it is taken to the assembly station where the (Roundup max) is entered into the plugs. This is performed in a ventilated section, where trained staff conduct the assembly process.

The powder is stored in a closed dry ventilated store room, before assembly takes place.

Once the plugs are filled it is placed into a plastic bag, then stored in a dry cardboard box ready for shipping.

All our procedures are set out by the Plastic Federation of South-Africa.
